A **\$500.00** deposit will be due at the time of booking to secure your tour. Deposit is fully refundable up to **April 30, 2007**. A 50% penalty on the deposit will be assessed for cancellations after this date. Final payment will be due on **July 15, 2007**. Periodic letters with extras, excursions and additional information as well as photo tips will be mailed after booking.

Items included are: all lodging, indicated meals, all ground transportation, Guides, Tour Leaders, park fees and local flights. All of the lodging will have clean rooms with private showers and toilets.

Items not included are: airfare*, beverages, items of a personal nature (laundry can be done in the lodges), tips and Kenya visa - currently \$50.

On this tour you have the opportunity to meet local peoples (Kenya has over 40 tribes while Tanzania has over 125), enjoy breath taking landscapes and see vast amounts of wildlife that include the Big Five - lion, leopard, rhino (black and white), elephant and cape buffalo. Other wildlife include three types of giraffe - Masai, Reticulated and Rothschild, two types of zebra - Grevy's and Burchell (Common), bat eared fox, cheetah, hyena, jackal, hippos, baboons, monkeys - blue, colobus and vervet, three types of gazelle - Gerenuk, Grant's and Thompson, impalas and a wide variety of other antelopes and exotic birds.

We limit the total number of people per van to six which ensures that everyone will have a window seat. The Tour Leaders and all the Guides take care of the entire group. You just have to take care of yourself and enjoy.

Migration Safari C Itinerary



October

17 (We) - Depart U.S. for your European gateway to Kenya.

18 (Th) - Depart your European gateway and arrive in Nairobi, Kenya. Transfer to The Stanley Hotel for overnight.

19 (Fr) - There will be a tour briefing at 8am, reviewing the itinerary with suggested 'Do's & Don'ts' to make your trip more pleasurable. Questions will be answered during this time.

Your first *surprise* comes this morning. Lunch will be at the Carnivore Restaurant. In the afternoon we will tour the Blixen House (*Out of Africa*) followed by a visit with the rare Rothschild Giraffe at the Langatta Giraffe Center. Overnight at The Stanley Hotel. (BL)

20 (Sa) - After breakfast we will go for a game drive in Nairobi National Park (NP). Prior to entering the park we will make a brief visit to the animal orphanage located at the park entrance. Return to The Stanley Hotel for lunch. Your afternoon is free. Third overnight at The Stanley Hotel. Possible *surprise* in the morning. We'll just have to wait and see once we get there. (BL)

21 (Su) - Morning departure for the Northern Frontier and the parks of Samburu, Buffalo Springs and Shaba. A *surprise* awaits along the way. We'll have our en-route lunch after we cross the equator. We'll have an afternoon game drive as we make our way to the Samburu Serena Lodge. (BLD)

22 (Mo) - Full day game viewing in search of animals indigenous to this area only. Optional visit to a Samburu tribal village (highly recommended). Second night at the Samburu Serena. (BLD)

23 (Tu) - Today we return south across the equator to Mt. Kenya and its surrounding bio-system. Overnight at your tree hotel - the Mountain Lodge. All night game viewing under floodlights around the water holes. (BLD)

24 (We) - Easy morning drive to Lake Nakuru via the town of Nyahururu - home of the famous Kenya marathon runners. We have a small *surprise* for you here. Afternoon game and bird viewing around the lake that is famous for its flamingoes - the pink lake seen from space. Overnight at the Lake Nakuru Lion Hill Lodge. (BLD)

25 (Th) - After breakfast depart for the Masai Mara - Kenya's extension of the Serengeti. We'll have an optional visit with a Maasai tribal village prior to entering the park (highly recommended). After we enter the park we will game drive en-route to our lodge. Overnight at the Mara Serena for the next three nights. (BLD)

26 (Fr) - Morning and afternoon game drives in wildlife paradise. There is an optional sunrise balloon safari available that includes a champagne breakfast out on the plains of the Masai Mara. (BLD)

27 (Sa) - Full day of game viewing in this great park searching for the Big Five. A special evening is planned for us but that *secret* will have to keep. (BLD)

28 (Su) - Return across the Masai Mara and on into Nairobi. A day room at The Stanley Hotel is provided for relaxation, showers and preparation for the evening departure to your European gateway. (BLD)

29 (Mo) - Once in your European gateway transfer to your flight back to the U.S.
