A **\$500.00** deposit will be due *no later than July 31, 2006*. You are welcome to send the check to us earlier than this date to ensure your space. Tour bookings will be on a first come first serve basis. Deposit is fully refundable up to **July 31, 2006**. A 50% penalty on the deposit will be assessed for cancellations after this date. The tour will not operate if fewer than 8 people sign up. Final payment will be due on **October 31, 2006**. Periodic letters with extras, excursions and additional information as well as photo tips will be mailed after **July 31, 2006**.

Please note: This tour was planned prior to having the 2007 tour prices available. The rates you'll find below are based on 2006 and are subject to change. Traditionally, prices do not increase more than 5% from year to year. I'll have the final price for this tour by the end of April. Use this flier as a guideline for dates, itinerary and estimate of costs.

Items included are: all lodging, indicated meals, all ground transportation, Guides, Tour Leaders, park fees and local flights. All of the lodging will have clean rooms with private showers and toilets.

Items not included are: airfare*, beverages, items of a personal nature (laundry can be done in the lodges), tips and Kenya and Tanzania visas - currently \$50.

* Current carriers flying into Nairobi, Kenya (NBO): British Air (BA), Egypt Air (MS), KLM (KL), Kenya Air (KQ), South African Airways (SA), Swiss (SR) and SN Brussels (SN).

On this tour you have the opportunity to meet local peoples (Kenya has over 40 tribes while Tanzania has over 125), enjoy breath taking landscapes and see vast amounts of wildlife that include the Big Five - lion, leopard, black rhino, elephant and cape buffalo. Other wildlife include giraffe, zebra, bat eared fox, cheetah, hyena, jackal, hippos, baboons, monkeys - blue, colobus and vervet, two types of gazelle - Grant's and Thompson, impalas and a wide variety of other antelopes and exotic birds.

We limit the total number of people per van to six which ensures that everyone will have a window seat. The Tour Leaders and all the Guides take care of the entire group. You just have to take care of yourself and enjoy.

Safari A Itinerary

Fall in love with one of the most provocative tour destinations in the world - East Africa. While on safari, experience an adventure that will guarantee unforgettable memories.

March

17 (Sa) - Depart U.S. for your European gateway to Kenya.

18 (Su) - Depart your European gateway and arrive in Nairobi, Kenya. Transfer to The Stanley Hotel for overnight.

19 (Mo) - There will be a tour briefing at 8am, reviewing the itinerary with suggested 'Do's & Don'ts' to make your trip more pleasurable. Questions will be answered during this time.

Lunch will be at the Carnivore Restaurant. In the afternoon we will tour the Blixen House (*Out of Africa*) followed by a visit with the rare Rothschild Giraffes at the Langatta Giraffe Center. Overnight at The Stanley Hotel. (BL)

20 (Tu) - After breakfast we will go for a game drive in Nairobi National Park (NP). Prior to entering the park we will make a brief visit to the animal orphanage located at the park entrance. Return to The Stanley Hotel for lunch. Your afternoon is free. Third overnight at The Stanley Hotel. (BL)

21 (We) - After breakfast we'll transfer to Nairobi's local Wilson Airport for our flight to Arusha, Tanzania. We'll make a connecting flight and arrive in the afternoon in the great Serengeti - Swahili for *endless plains*. Game drive en-route to our lodge - Serengeti Serena. Overnight. (BLD)

22 (Th) - Optional sunrise balloon safari. Full day of game drives in this fantastic animal kingdom. At 5600 square miles the Serengeti is **EIGHT** times larger than the northern part of this eco-system in Kenya - the famous Masai Mara. Overnight again at the Serengeti Serena Lodge. (BLD)

23 (Fr) - Optional sunrise balloon safari. Another full day of game drives in wildlife paradise. This is the traditional time of year that the Great Migration (wildebeest, zebra, gazelle, hartebeest and eland) should be in the southern part of the Serengeti. This is also the birthing season for zebra and wildebeest. Overnight at the Serengeti Serena. (BLD)

24 (Sa) - After breakfast depart for the Eighth Natural Wonder of the World - Ngorongoro Crater (a caldera or collapsed volcano). We will make an en-route stop at the Olduvai Gorge - 'cradle of mankind'. There is a small museum here at Olduvai, seemingly in the middle of nowhere, that is surprisingly good. We'll arrive at the Ngorongoro Serena in the afternoon. Overnight. (BLD)

25 (Su) - Entire day will be spent 2000 feet down on the floor of this fabulous crater which is teeming with wildlife. This is one of the best places to see black rhinos. The crater elephants also have some of the largest tusks in all of Africa. Picnic lunch at one of the hippo pools. Late afternoon return to the Ngorongoro Serena Lodge for overnight. (BLD)

26 (Mo) - After breakfast depart for Tarangire with an en-route stopover at an Iraqw tribal village and then on to the Gibbs Farm coffee plantation. Explore the beautiful gardens and partake in the light hike to the local waterfall (optional). We'll enjoy lunch here before proceeding to Tarangire NP. Game drive en-route to the Tarangire Sopa Lodge. (BLD)

27 (Tu) - Morning and afternoon game drives in Tarangire - home of the giant Baobab trees. Overnight at Tarangire Sopa Lodge. (BLD)

28 (We) - After breakfast we'll game drive as we exit the park and head north for Kenya. We'll stop in Arusha for lunch prior to heading across the border and into Amboseli NP. Once in the park we'll game drive en-route to Amboseli Serena Lodge. Overnight. (BLD)

29 (Th) - Full day of game drives at the base of the tallest free standing mountain in the world and Africa's highest point - Mt. Kilimanjaro. Look for the elephants from the IMAX movie *Elephant Kingdom*. Optional visit to a Maasai village in the afternoon. Overnight at Amboseli Serena. (BLD)

30 (Fr) - After breakfast we'll game drive en-route as we leave the park. Continuing north we make our way back to Nairobi and your day room at The Stanley. You'll have lunch up at the pool before getting yourself ready for your trip back to the U.S. Early evening departure for the airport. Depart for Europe and your gateway back home. (BL)

31 (Sa) - Once in your European gateway transfer to your flight back to your final destination.
